QUESTION 1

You work as a System Administrator for company Inc. You have to set up five servers and ten workstations per specification. Your organization uses Windows Deployment Services whenever a new workstation or server is set up.

You want to automate the installations with as little human interaction as possible.

Which of the following will you use to accomplish the task?

- A. ImageX
- B. System Preparation Tool 3.14
- C. Setup Manager
- D. Windows System Image Manager

Correct Answer: D

In order to accomplish the task, you should use Windows System Image Manager. Windows System Image Manager (Windows SIM) is a Windows Server 2016 tool to create Windows Server 2016 answer files. It saves unattended answer files in XML format. By using Windows SIM, administrators can verify that an unattended answer file actually produces the desired result. Windows SIM is included with the Windows Automated Installation Kit (Windows AIK). The answer file automatically provides the answers to the setup question: configures and installs necessary software during the installation process.

Incorrect Answers:

A: ImageX is a command-line tool that captures, modifies, and applies installation images for deployment in a large environment. ImageX uses the Microsoft Windows Imaging Format (WIM) image format. ImageX captures a volume to a WIM file and applies a WIM file to a volume.

B: System Preparation Tool 3.14 (SYSPREP) is used to capture an image of the reference computer so that it can be used on multiple client computers. SYSPREP 3.14 allows administrators to duplicate a custom image of the Windows Server 2008/Vista/Windows 10 installation from a master computer to the destination computers. The SYSPREP tool can be found in the % SystemRoot%\System32\Syseprep folder of the Windows Vista or Windows Server 2016 installation.

C: The Setup Manager tool can be used to create an answer file and to configure a limited number of answer file settings. It is included in the DEPLOY.CAB file in the Support folder on the Windows Server 2003 operating system CD. Setup Manager is used only with the Windows XP Professional or Windows Server 2003 operating systems to create answer files for unattended installations.

QUESTION 2

Andy, Managing Director of the company, complains that his laptop is consuming battery very rapidly affecting the performance of the system. Adam inspects his laptop and finds that appropriate power is implemented on the laptop but many USB devices are attached to it.

Adam will enable the USB selective suspend option from the Advanced Power Settings. USB devices draw power from a computer. USB selective suspend option in Windows 10 can be used to reduce the power usage of some USB devices.

USB selective suspend is enabled in Windows 10 by default when laptop runs on battery.

Advance Power Plan settings are used to customize the power setting according to the individual computer. To configure the advanced power plan settings, click the Change Advanced Power Settings item in the Edit Plan Settings dialog box.

Unlike the basic plan settings, only a user with elevated privileges can modify advanced power plan settings.

Full backups with incremental backups start with a full backup followed by several incremental backups. For example, once a week, you would perform a full backup on Friday night, which shuts off the archive attribute indicating that the files were backed up. Then any new files or changed files would have the archive attribute turned on. You would then perform an incremental backup Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday night, which only backs up new and changed files and shuts off the archive attribute.

QUESTION 9

You are configuring a RAID 5 solution on a server running Windows Server 2016. You are using five 750GB hard drives in the RAID array.

How much free space will you get after configuring the RAID 5 solution?

After configuring the RAID 5 solution, you get 3,000GB free space. You can calculate free space for a RAID 5 solution using the following formula: Available free space for RAID 5 = Total drive space - 1/n (Total drive space) where, n is the number of hard drives According to the question: = 5 x 750 = 3,750GB Free space for the RAID 5 solution = 3,750 - 1/5 (3,750) = 3,750 - 750 = 3,000GB

Direct-attached storage (DAS) refers to a digital storage system directly attached to a server or workstation, without a storage network in between. A typical DAS system is made of a data storage device connected directly to a computer through a host bus adapter (HBA). Between those two points, there is no network device (like hub, switch, or router), and this is the main characteristic of DAS. The main protocols used for DAS connections are ATA, SATA, eSATA, SCSI, SAS, and Fibre Channel.

Incorrect Answers:

B: Serial Attached SCSI (SAS) is a computer bus used to move data to and from computer storage devices such as hard drives and tape drives. SAS depends on a point-to-point serial protocol that replaces the parallel SCSI bus technology. SAS offers backwards-compatibility with second-generation SATA drives.

C: Network Attached Storage (NAS) is the hard disk storage that is set up with its own network address rather than being attached to the unit computer that is serving applications of a network's workspace users. A fully-featured operating system is not needed on a NAS device, so often a stripped-down operating system is used. NAS provides both storage and a file system.

D: SAN stands for storage area network. It is an architecture to attach remote computer storage devices to servers in such a way that the devices appear as locally attached to the operating system. Sharing storage usually simplifies storage administration and adds flexibility since cables and storage devices do not have to be physically moved to shift storage from one server to another. SANs also tend to enable more effective disaster recovery processes.
